

Three embassies in Berlin

Prof. Rita Süßmuth holds laudation for Prof. Cornelia Pieper to the German-Hungarian Society, Zoz invites Taiwanese Ambassador Shieh and Lamborghini-CFO Poma to Wenden City Hall

Wenden/Berlin

Last Tuesday, on 28.11.2017, Prof. Zoz, upon the invitation of the Hungarian Ambassador S. E. Peter Györkös and the German-Hungarian Society in the Federal Republic of Germany e.V. (DUG) traveled to Berlin to attend the solemn award of Prof. Dr. Cornelia Pieper, Federal Minister and Vice President of the German Bundestag a. D., to be an honorary member of the DUG. For Zoz, this has been the second visit to Dr. Györkös this year and the first time to getting to know the DUG.

About 100 attendees came to the embassy "Unter den Linden" and were welcomed by the host of the house as well as by the president of the DUG, Dr. Peter Spary. The ceremonial address was contributed by Prof. Dr. Rita Süßmuth, DUG Honorary Member and President of the German Bundestag a. D.





Addressing the currently regrettably poor political relations between Germany and Hungary of course could not be failed. As per Zoz, the major failures are on the German side and in this tenor he exchanged ideas with Prof. Süßmuth, who on the contrary in her speech mentioned the "incredible achievements of NGOs and others related to boat people on the Mediterranean".

Zoz argues that "we and Germany like a magnet do attract most of these people to the water and are responsible for causing much misery by inviting everyone into our social security system, not to mention forgetting our own people so far. Insofar it is really true that Germany abolishes itself and also destroys Europe in the same raid".



After plenty of delicious Hungarian goulash and upon a spontaneous proposal of Dipl.-Ing. Ilona Wiener, Chair of the Federal Association of Bi-national Societies e. V., Zoz rushed to an evening-event in the Taipei/Taiwan representation at Markgrafenstrasse. For Zoz this has been particularly of interest since a very good customer of Zoz is based in Tainan/Taiwan. Zoz talked exactly about this with the Taiwan representative, S. E. Prof. Dr. Ihy-Wey Shieh and upfront also with the Deputy Foreign Affairs Minister Francois Dr. Chih-Chung Wu. Zoz reported that just this April he had traveled to Taiwan with two of his sons for attending a powder metallurgy conference in Hsinshu/Taiwan, mainly organized by the good partner Chairman Chiu Lung Chu from Porite at Miaoli and for visiting Solar Applied Materials Technology Corp. the day before in Tainan, meeting many Taiwan and overall Asia friends.



Both diplomats do know SolarTech and Zoz reported that 3 times already a workshop has been organized by Zoz each taking place at Solar's headquarter. Also, the former CEO and today's Chairman, Dr. Chien-Yung Ma came to Wenden (where Zoz is headquartered) several times e. g. on the occasion of the OZ-Nanostructure-Symposium, however he has not yet confirmed attending the upcoming event in March 2018. Prof. Zoz suggested insofar, that he would write to Dr. Ma the other day telling him, that once he would come back to Wenden City Hall (OZ-18 venue) in March, that then the ambassador would be there, too. Prof. Shieh agreed to this plan and exactly for this purpose the joint photo with the invitation flyer OZ-18 has been taken.



The surprise and the evening was the reunion with Dr. Volker Stanzel, whom Zoz met in 2013 as the German Ambassador to Japan on the occasion of OZ-13 in Japan (co-organizer Prof. Dr. Key Ameyama, Ritsumeikan University) and who today works as a pensioner in the Science and Politics Foundation. Possibly also Dr. Stanzel might be seen at the nanostructure meeting soon.

The other day, yesterday on Wednesday, Zoz visited the Italian Representation at Hiroshima Street and insofar third embassy in a row. On the occasion of the German-Italian Innovation Conference, Dr. Zoz talked to Paolo Poma, CFO & Managing Director of the sports car manufacturer Automobili Lamborghini S.p.A. headquartered at Sant'Agata Bolognese. Zoz, himself an enthusiastic Diablo driver, invited to a materials-presentation from Lamborghini during OZ-18 and Mr. Poma confirmed.



Zoz spoke with Stefano Firpo, Director General of the Italian Ministry of Economic Development about the very poor relation of the Zoz-materials/-technology corporation with Italy res. with Italian companies. E. g. with respect to Zoz nanostructured super concrete (e. g. public Bridge Rosenthal at Olpe/Germany), the originally German cement-partner Dyckerhoff had been acquired by the Italian Buzzi Cement Group and since that time the cooperation practically expired. For improving, Zoz and Firpo have agreed some joint interaction on short-term. That actually happened in the taxi to the airport, since both had to leave already in the morning. Right before leaving, also Ms. Wiener arrived at the Embassy.
